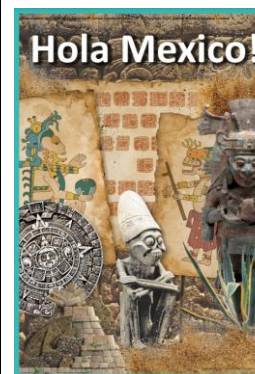
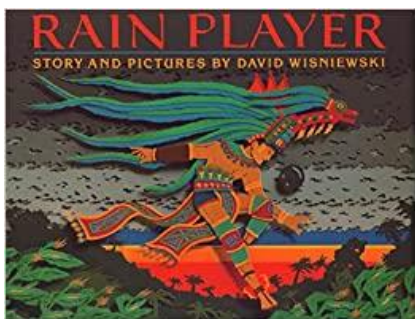
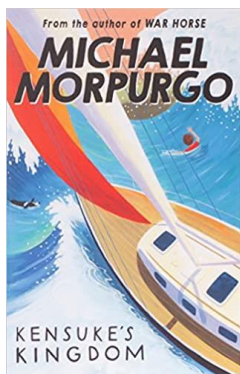

Autumn Term part 1

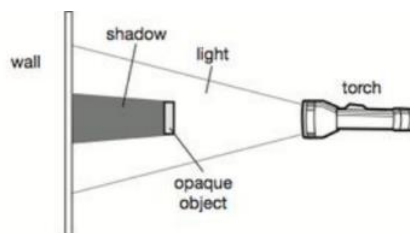
Hola Mexico
