As **readers** we will be exploring a range of texts including 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes.
As **writers** we will be looking to write descriptive narratives, including speech.

As **scientists** we will be:
Introducing a range of different forces.
Investigating the magnetic properties of a range of everyday materials and using this to sort them effectively.
Investigating magnets and magnetic forces.

As **mathematicians** we will be covering key objectives from the National Curriculum including:
Multiplying and Dividing a 2 digit number by a single digit.
Measuring in metres, centimetres and millimetres and finding their equivalents.
Measuring and calculating perimeter.

In **RE** we will be learning what a god means to Muslims.

As **geographers** we will be creating maps of the local area and marking places of interest on them.

As **artists** we will be exploring colour and a range of artistic techniques.

In **PSHE** we will be learning about my dreams and goals and how to overcome challenges.

In **Music** we will be learning how to play the steel drums (3B and 3I) or the JSax (3S).

As **Computer Scientists** we will be learning how to put together simple codes and algorithms to program a computer to complete a desired function. We will also be learning how to stay safe online.

In **PE** we will be doing either Hockey, Dance, Football, Basketball or swimming. We will also be developing our fundamental ball skills and fitness.

In **French** we will be learning the French vocabulary for parts of the body, days of the week and animals and pets.
