As readers we will be exploring a range of texts including 'Black Dog' by Levi Pinfold and some performance poetry.  As writers we will be looking to write descriptive narratives, including speech.	As Historians we will be studying Ancient Greece, including: Ordering key events on a timeline, Using evidence to understand the major changes during this period and how they have influenced modern life. Comparing different accounts of the same event.	As mathematicians we will be covering key objectives from the National Curriculum including: Measuring and calculating perimeter. Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects: unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators. Measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (I/mI)
In RE we will be looking at why symbols and artefacts are important to religions.	As geographers we will be using maps and atlases to identify the location and coastlines of Greece. We will also be comparing geographic similarities and differences between Norfolk and areas of Greece.	As artists we will be using different grades of pencil to draw different forms and shapes and exploring the use of different materials including clay.
In PSHE we will be learning how to keep fit and healthy and how to keep safe.	In DT we will be drawing labelled sketches, planning, designing and making a Labyrinth marble maze.	As Computer Scientists we will be continuing to learn how to put together simple codes and algorithms, as well as learning basic word processing skills.
In PE we will be outdoor and adventurous activities.	In Music we will be composing tunes using treble clef notation. We will perform these tunes on xylophones. 3S will be continuing to learn the J Sax and will be playing tunes using the notes, B,A,G.	In French we will be learning the vocabulary associated with animals and pets and continuing to learn our numbers to 20.
