



## Year 3 Summer Term part 1 FLOW



As **readers** we will be exploring a range of texts including 'Dragonology' by Ernest Drake and a range of poetry.  
As **writers** we will be looking to write explanation texts using a wide range of descriptive skills.

As **geographers** we will be using maps and atlases to identify the key geographical features, mountains, coastlines and rivers of the UK. We will be following the journey of a river as well as identifying the four stages of the water cycle.

As **mathematicians** we will be covering key objectives from the National Curriculum including:  
Adding and subtracting fractions,  
Finding fractions of a quantity,  
Using money and solving problems involving money.

In **RE** we will be looking at how Christians belong to their faith.

In **DT** we will be examining the structure of bridges and using this knowledge to inform our own bridge designs.

As **artists** we will be looking at artists including Monet and Seurat and exploring how they use light and dark in their paintings. We will be using these artists to inspire our own art work.

In **PSHE** we will be learning about different relationships between family and friends, children around the world and how to be safe online.

In **Music** 3S and 3I will be singing in rounds on the theme of 'Rivers'. We will be composing a 'River Journey' using percussion instruments. 3B will be learning how to play the JSax.

As **Computer Scientists** we will be learning about how to be safe online, how to communicate with others and how to be careful with online adverts.

In **PE** we will be looking at athletics and preparing our skills for sports day. We will also be learning how to play Rounders, Cricket and Tennis.

In **French** we will be learning about members of the family and the French alphabet.
