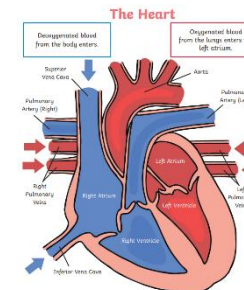


Year 6 Summer Term part 1 Blood Heart



As **readers** we will examine how authors portray and describe characters.

As **writers** we will learn to recognise and use the features of a balanced argument.

As **scientists** we will be identifying and naming the main parts of the human circulatory system; describing the functions of the heart; blood vessels and blood, identifying and naming the main parts of the human respiratory system; and recognising the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on our bodies.

As **artists** we will be working independently to develop our own style when painting and learning about the use of colour, tone and shade.

As **mathematicians** we will be covering key objectives from the National Curriculum including:

- Recognise angles where they meet at a point, are on a straight line, or are vertically opposite, and find missing angles
- Compare and classify geometric shapes based on their properties and sizes and find unknown angles in any triangles, quadrilaterals, and regular polygons

In **PSHE** we will be learning about emotions and friendships.

In **DT** we will be learning about how key individuals and their inventions/discoveries have changed the world.

In **computing** we will be taking a look at types of computer networks and ways to communicate online.

In **PE** we will be enjoying units on cricket, athletics, rounders, swimming and tennis.

In **music** we will be composing music to act as scores for silent movies.

In **French** we will be learning the vocabulary for rooms of the house, how to describe activities within the home and say what we do at the weekend.
