Year 3 Summer Term part 2

Light and Shadows Plants, Animals & Us

As readers we will be exploring a range of texts including 'The Secret Of Black Rock' by Joe Todd Stanton and a selection of poetry.

As writers we will be looking to write adventure stories and poems using a wide range of descriptive skills and techniques.

In RE we will be looking at how Christians belong to their faith family.

In PSHE we will be learning about how babies grow and how bodies change to make babies. We will also be learning about different roles in different families.

In PE we will be looking at athletics and preparing our skills for sports day. We will also be learning how to play Rounders, Cricket and Tennis.

As Scientists we will be studying two topics: Light and Shadow and Plants, Animals and Us. In these topics we will be learning:

How light travels,

How shadows are made and how they change, How to protect ourselves from the sun.

The key features of a plant and their functions Growing conditions of plants The life cycle of flowering plants

How humans and animals require nutrition How animals and humans have skeletons and muscles for support.

In Music 3S and 3I will be learning to sing playground songs. We will compose our own playground song. 3B will be continuing to learn how to play the saxophone, including tunes using the notes B, A and G.

Light and Shadows

As mathematicians we will be covering key objectives from the National Curriculum including:

Telling the time and solving time problems.

Recognising, identifying features of and drawing 2 and 3D shapes

Reading and drawing pictograms and bar graphs. Handling and collecting data.

As artists we will be looking at drawing different aspects of nature including plants and animals, using a range of techniques and mediums.

As Computer Scientists we will be learning how to make a branching adventure story using Powerpoint.

In French we will be learning about family members, household items, food vocabulary and the numbers 21-31.
