


Drayton C of E Junior School Curriculum Map







Year 6 Summer Term part 2 Revolution







As readers we will be explore how historical characters and events are portrayed. We will be using non-fiction texts to develop our research skills.

As writers we will be writing to inform about the Victorian workhouse and writing a persuasive letter in character.



As mathematicians we will be revising key skills in preparation for high school as well as exploring mathematical patterns in art and nature.





As historians we will be examining the changes made by Queen Victoria and the impact it has on our lives today. We will be asking how powerful Queen Victoria was and looking at how the power of monarchy has changed over time.

In PSHE we will be learning about how to take care of our mental health. We will examine how to recognise our emotions and investigate strategies to manage them. We will also be learning about puberty and conception.

As artists we will be learning facts about notable Victorian artists and comparing and contrasting their styles.

As geographers we will understand how coal and its transportation was fundamental to the industrial revolution.

In DT we will be designing, making and evaluating a Victorian room model.

In computing we will be completing a project involving stop motion and learning about computer networks. We will be using our computer skills to create our own personalised yearbooks.

In PE we will be improving our skills in athletics and preparing for sports day. We will also be enjoying cricket, rounders and tennis.

In music we will be learning songs and preparing to perform our end of year production.

In French we will be learning how to talk about our homes, hobbies and days of the week.
